

**KONKURS JĘZYKA ANGIELSKIEGO "EDUSMART"**  
**DLA UCZNIÓW SZKÓŁ PODSTAWOWYCH GMINY CZERWIONKA-LESZCZYN**  
**W ROKU SZKOLNYM 2024/25**



**REGULAMIN**

**1. Postanowienia ogólne**

1.1. Konkurs z języka angielskiego organizowany przez **besmart Agnieszka Groborz** oraz **Szkołę Podstawową nr 4 im. Tadeusza Kościuszki w Czerwionce-Leszczynach ul. Furgoła 71** (zwanymi dalej „Organizatorami”) jest skierowany do uczniów szkół podstawowych w gminie Czerwionka-Leszczyny.

1.2. Konkurs ma na celu rozwijanie umiejętności językowych uczniów oraz promowanie nauki języka angielskiego wśród dzieci.

1.3. Konkurs zostanie przeprowadzony w czterech kategoriach wiekowych, w zależności od poziomu znajomości języka angielskiego:

- Pre-A1 Starters - dla klas II, III
- A1 Movers - dla klas IV
- A2 Flyers - dla klas V, VI
- A2 Key - dla klas VII, VIII

**2. Warunki uczestnictwa**

2.1. Uczestnikiem konkursu może być każdy uczeń szkoły podstawowej, który spełnia poniższe wymagania:

- jest uczniem jednej ze szkół podstawowych w gminie Czerwionka-Leszczyny,
- zarejestruje swój udział w konkursie w terminie określonym przez Organizatorów,
- posiada odpowiedni poziom językowy (zgodnie z podziałem na kategorie wiekowe),
- wypełni i dostarczy - Zgodę RODO dla opiekunów uczestników konkursu.

2.2. Zgłoszenia do konkursu należy dokonać poprzez wypełnienie dokumentu **"LISTY UCZESTNIKÓW ZGŁOSZONYCH DO KONKURSU Z JĘZYKA ANGIELSKIEGO "EDUSMART"** a następnie przesłanie tej listy do dnia 30.04.2025 na adres e-mail: [kasia@edusmart.com.pl](mailto:kasia@edusmart.com.pl)  
Maksymalna liczba zgłoszonych uczniów to 4 osoby na każdy poziom, czyli w sumie maksymalnie 16 uczniów z danej szkoły.

2.3 Wymagane jest dostarczenie zgód RODO dla opiekunów uczestników konkursu w formie papierowej od wszystkich uczestników konkursu najpóźniej w dniu konkursu tj. 27.05.2025r.

### **3. Przebieg konkursu**

3.1. Konkurs będzie miał formę pisemną. Obowiązuje podany zakres materiału, który dołączony jest jako załącznik do regulaminu.

3.2. Część pisemna konkursu obejmować będzie ćwiczenia leksykalne:

- testy wyboru,
- testy z lukami,
- kategoryzowanie,
- dopasowywanie,
- odnajdywanie ukrytych wyrazów,
- podawanie wyrazów przeciwnych lub bliskoznacznych,
- rozwiązywanie krzyżówek,
- podpisywanie elementów,
- sety leksykalne,
- uzupełnianie tekstu.

3.3. Czas trwania konkursu na każdym poziomie będzie wynosił od 30 do 60 minut, w zależności od poziomu.

3.4. Na każdym z poziomów przewidziane są nagrody:

- za zajęcie I miejsca - bon podarunkowy o wartości 150 zł, dyplom uczestnictwa w konkursie oraz różne gadżety;
- za zajęcie II miejsca - bon podarunkowy o wartości 100 zł, dyplom uczestnictwa w konkursie oraz różne gadżety;
- za zajęcie III miejsca - bon podarunkowy o wartości 50 zł, dyplom uczestnictwa w konkursie oraz różne gadżety;

Wszyscy pozostali uczestnicy otrzymają dyplom oraz drobny gadżet.

3.5. W przypadku, gdy dwóch lub więcej uczestników konkursu zdobędzie tę samą liczbę punktów na danym poziomie, zostanie przeprowadzona dogrywka w celu wyłonienia zwycięzcy. Poniżej znajdują się zasady dotyczące organizacji dogrywki:

3.5.1 Forma dogrywki: Dogrywka zostanie przeprowadzona w formie ustnej. Uczestnicy będą mieli za zadanie przeliterować przy użyciu alfabetu angielskiego wylosowane zestawy słów.

3.5.2. Kryteria oceny: Zadanie dogrywkowe będzie oceniane przez zebraną komisję konkursową.

3.5.3. Wyniki: Uczestnik, który uzyska najwyższą ocenę w dogrywce, zostanie ogłoszony zwycięzcą. W przypadku kolejnego remisu, organizatorzy zastrzegają sobie prawo do przeprowadzenia kolejnej rundy dogrywkowej.

Dogrywka jest integralną częścią konkursu i jej zasady są nieodwołalne. Uczestnicy, którzy nie przystąpią do dogrywki, zostaną automatycznie zdyskwalifikowani z możliwości zdobycia nagrody głównej.

4.3. Ogłoszenie wyników: **w tym samym dniu.**
